Children

As some of you may know, my youngest boy started Kindergarten in August. I had several people ask me what I was going to do with all my spare time. And to be honest, I was wondering the same thing! But the last few months have flown by. As much as I miss my little one being at home, it has given me time to work on improving the children's department.

I have been working on a policies and procedures document which entails guidelines that will be used in the nursery and children's department. These documents will contain important information for workers, such as how to spot and report suspected child abuse. In this day and age, all workers need to be able to spot the warning signs. It will also outline the steps we will proceed with if there are behavior problems, sickness, etc. I hope to have this finished around the first of the year. Another item I have been laying the groundwork for is a child check-in and check-out system also to be implemented around the first of the year. Praise the Lord we are seeing new faces almost every Sunday, and with a child check-in/check-out system, this will give visitors peace of mind that their child is in good hands. This new system will also give the Church a chance to get all the family's information for follow-up with that family.

In August we started a Wednesday evening program for the children ages five through fifth grade called Exploration Kids. We are averaging 10-11 kids in this program. We are using a curriculum called "Exploring the Bible" which is just fantastic! Each child has their own "Explorer Guide" that reinforces the lesson learned that day. There is a short 5-8 minute video that we watch every week that reinforces the main lesson while the children enjoy a snack. We have also been learning new songs that the children really enjoy.

October 19 was our Harvest Festival and puppet show. We had roughly 300 people attend! A HUGE PRAISE I want to share with you is the fact that we were allowed by the El Dorado Public Schools Superintendent Sue Givens, to take flyers to each of the elementary school's offices and the schools distributed the flyers to all of the children. We printed and cut approximately 1000 flyers. This was a God thing because we have never been allowed to do that before! There was a sign-up for a drawing and through that we have lots of new contact information. Postcards inviting them back were sent out last week. I want to give a huge THANK YOU to all the volunteers who showed up to help. *"Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for God's Glory."* 1 Corinthians 10:31
