
# The Five Stages of Discipleship

# Needs 1. Primarily, a strong relational connection to a mature believer so they can make the transition to a more God– and kingdom-focused life.

- Learn to trust God in obedience, doing what the Word says rather than what their feelings tell them

Characterized by

Making a shift from being self-centered to being God— and other-centered. Beginning to reorient their lives around God's Word and his people and mission. Starting to understand God has called them to give to the body of Christ, rather than simply take. They are involved in ministering to others, putting their needs first, and being doers of the Word, all for the right reasons. Serve God with zeal, energy and joy provided by the Spirit. Understand God has created them for a purpose. Priorities have changed. Look for places to serve. Growing less judgmental and find it easier to overlook others' faults. Learning to be faithful, even when lacking desire, fitting their skills and passions in God's kingdom purposes..
