- **32** Indeed, a king will reign righteously, and rulers will rule justly.
- ²Each will be like a shelter from the wind, a refuge from the rain, like flowing streams in a dry land and the shade of a massive rock in an arid land.
- ³Then the eyes of those who see will not be closed, and the ears of those who hear will listen.
- ⁴The reckless mind will gain knowledge, and the stammering tongue will speak clearly and fluently.

Oh, what comfort these words bring to our troubled times! There is a King of Kings who will reign! And righteously! And those He puts in leadership will rule justly!
