I recently attended the 2021 Convention of Southern Baptists in Nashville, Tennessee, as a messenger from our church. You will be glad to hear (and I am glad to report!) that I saw everything that is good and right about our denomination on display! Although there were predictions in social media of great conflict and division coming, the false prophets were mistaken as God answered our prayers by bringing His uniting, peaceful presence. Our unity for the advancement of the Gospel to the Nations, our devotion to the Scriptures as the Word of God, and our respectful kindness were all on display as we deliberated the business of the event. Some important highlights:

- We confessed our need for God. A Sunday night prayer meeting was set up for just over 1000 people. It was standing room only! One powerful convention speaker proclaimed, "If God is with us, nothing else matters. If God is not with us, nothing else matters."
 - Several new campaigns were introduced:
 - Who's Your One? is an evangelism campaign which encourages us to each choose one person we know who may not know Jesus to begin

praying for them to come to know Jesus and for an opportunity to have a Gospel conversation. Then we commit to having that Gospel conversation with them. Go to www.whosyourone.com to get more information and register your commitment.

- ♦ SEND Relief is a cooperative effort of the North American Mission Board (NAMB) and the International Mission Board (IMB) to get relief funds available to missionaries to help with human needs so that a hearing of the Gospel may be opened. Go to www.sendrelief.org for ways you can be involved!
- The NAMB reported that even in the middle of the pandemic, 588 new churches were planted, 143 established churches affiliated with us, 126 new campus ministries were begun, for a total of 857 new outposts for the Gospel.
 - SBC churches baptized 235,000 people in 2019. Baptisms are trending consistently down. The largest percentage of those baptisms were in churches planted in the last 10 years.
 - In 2020, 237 people went through SEND Network training assessment retreat (virtually, due to the pandemic) with 85% approved to move toward planting a church.

- The IMB reported that every day 154,937 people die without Christ (one precious person every 2 seconds). More than 215,000 people join our world every day. Yet estimates indicate that evangelical Christians share the Gospel about 275,000 times per week. We cannot we must not be passive in our efforts toward Gospel advance. We must be strong, focused, and committed. Our missionaries are on the march!
 - ♦ 535,325 people heard a Gospel witness last year as IMB missionaries and their indigenous partners continue to share the Gospel boldly.
 - 89,325 people committed to follow Jesus Christ, with 47,929 following through with believer's baptism.
 - ♦ 12,368 new churches were planted.
 - ♦ Missionaries reported 174,393 participants in ongoing Bible Study.
 - 90,532 people received theological training, including pastoral training, church-planting training, advanced training, and more.

In the Monday afternoon session, I was able to witness the moving sending of 57 new missionaries to nearly every region of the world!

The urgency of sharing the Gospel hits home to us in our church as well. We must answer the call to rebuild our church! Please try to join us each week the rest of the summer as we wrestle with this calling. Additionally, please come July 11 to our Family Meeting following our monthly potluck dinner. We will be having a very important conversation about what our church is going to have to consider if we are going to grow. We may have to look at doing things very differently. Please come!

Above all, please keep on praying!

Operation Christmas Child

Wow, can you believe that this year is halfway over? I just wanted to take a moment to remind or tell you about the amazing journey of these simple shoebox gifts we pack. It all begins with you and results in evangelism, discipleship, and multiplication.

Packing

From children to seniors, people pack shoebox gifts each year to bless children in need around the world. Parents often use the project to teach their kids about giving. Year-round volunteers support these efforts across the country.

Collecting

Churches and groups of all sizes collect boxes from their communities. Some churches also serve as drop-off locations for shoeboxes the 3rd week of November every year.

Shipping

Thousands of volunteers serve annually inspecting and preparing shoeboxes for international

shipping. Every hour work stops for and invite children to participate in a few minutes to pray for the children who will receive the boxes.

Worldwide Distribution

Long before shoeboxes arrive in more than 100 countries, volunteer National Leadership Teams train pastors and community leaders who want to share the message of the Gospel and bless children. The leaders learn how to host child-friendly outreach events, and how to implement "The Greatest Journey" follow-up discipleship program.

Outreach Events

Pastors around the world host outreach events in places where people may not know Christ and invite them to follow Him. Other churches use the boxes as resources for outreach in orphanages and other at-risk areas. instead, that is fine. Mark on your In many places, they also offer "The Greatest Gift", a Gospel story booklet Samaritan's Purse developed for shoebox recipients,

The Greatest Journey discipleship program.

Discipleship & Multiplication

As a result of what they learn in The Greatest Journey, boys and girls grow in Christ and share with friends and family. The students also invite others to their graduations where the Gospel is shared. This often brings parents, siblings, and friends to accept Christ and become active members in the local church. Families are reached, churches grow, new churches are started, and communities are transformed.
