THE PASTOR'S PEN



Greetings Church! I love you, Church! There are three significant processes underway regarding the future of our church as addressed at our family meeting July 27. My article this month informs you about how we expect the process to unfold.

Copies of the revised youth pastor job description are available at the church for the congregation's review. It is edited to reflect the votes from the floor at the family meeting and also a verbiage change from the A-Team meeting August 10. It is not intended to outline every ideal we are looking for in a candidate. It is intended to briefly and generally outline the information a candidate might be needing to decide their interest in the position. A final job description will be written based on the search process and candidate strengths. callings, education, and church needs and based less on qualifications and more on duties

and responsibilities. That final job description will be approved by the whole congregation, per our bylaws, alongside our vote to call the final candidate at the end of the search process and a vote to amend our budget to reflect the youth pastor salary.

The first step is to open the position by congregational vote at a specially called family meeting on August 24. Once the position is opened, the church must approve a search team to do the work of promoting the position, survey the needs of the congregation in a youth pastor, vet the candidates through processing the applications, selecting a short list of candidates to interview, and narrowing the selection to a single candidate to present to the congregation alongside a final job description.

The A-team has prepared an initial list of people to formulate the search team, made up primarily of parents and youth ministry

volunteers. The A-Team has voted that the search team be chaired by Pastor David Crook and that he begin soliciting the interest of each person on the list to be part of the team so that they can be presented to the congregation as willing to serve.

Please continue to pray for the process and the people involved, namely candidates and search team.

At the family meeting, you also approved the formation of two study teams. The A-Team has also formulated a list of people to solicit interest in serving and suggest to the congregation. They have voted to ask deacon John Brickley to chair the Building Addition Study Team and deacon Rod Luehrs to chair the Rebranding Study Team. Once those teams have been constituted, they will begin meeting to begin fulfilling their assignments. Their work will take months of hard work. Their task is to study their individual subjects. They will not

make decisions for the church. They will present their findings, perhaps alongside some suggestions, to the congregation for consideration.

These teams will report to and work with the deacon body and the A-Team along the way. I will be

involved with both teams the whole way. If you have any questions, you are welcome to contact the chair any time along the way. Please do so with a prayer-grounded spirit and a desire to help your church reach the future God has for us. Prayer and

unity will be keys to the success of not only these team processes but all of the future God has for our church family.

Thanks for who you are and all you do!




Hello friends!
