Hot dogs will be free and food trucks might also be available. The theme is "The Cross." Every hour contains a musical group and a speaker who either brings their testimony or a message. Erik Hauck and I will be doing the program together at 4. We will be doing a camp-style cross service. It will be an amazing climax to a wonderful day.

I certainly hope that you will make plans to attend at least some of the day. But I hope you will take it much further than that. First, I hope you will spend some time every day praying for the event and real, sweeping revival. Pray that the Spirit of God will come over this city and the event in such a way that hearts all over our city long to touch the heart of God! Pray for Christ to be exalted, barriers to be broken, the Body of Christ to be united, and the lost to be saved! I have a reminder on my phone at 10:04 to pray these things. I hope you will join me.

But that is not all I want to challenge you to do. Every bit as important as your prayers and attendance is that you invite someone to come with you who needs to know Jesus. God is pleased with our worship, our faithfulness, our adoration, our service, our prayers, and our obedience. But a party breaks out in the halls of Heaven when a lost sinner comes home! What if YOU were the reason a celestial party breaks out October 4!? What a glorious day that would be!

It is officially that time of year to start thinking about getting our shoeboxes packed and ready. Earlier this year, we filled baby bottles with our spare change to help Branches, our local pregnancy and family resource center. Starting the first Sunday in **October**, **the 5**th, we will have the chance to fill little shoebox banks with money to cover the shipping for our boxes. Shipping cost is \$10 per box. This amount is critical to cover project costs involved in collecting, processing, and shipping your shoebox gifts to over 170 countries. It also provides for ministry materials such as *The Greatest Gift* Gospel Booklet and The Ministry Partner Guide. Please bring back your shoebox bank by Sunday, **November 24**th. Our goal is to pack 250 boxes this year.

Our church packing party will be held Sunday, November 16th, right after church. We will also have a soup and sandwich lunch after we pack.

We are still in need of items for our boxes. We want each box to be fun, full, and personalized. Please look over the shopping list to the right.

The kids would love to see and hear from the one from whom they got their gifts. Thanks again for all your help. If you can't make it and would still like to participate, here are a couple alternatives:


